

RING SIZING GUIDE

Please take care to follow all directions closely for an accurate measurement

1 Before using the ring sizing guides, please check your print out using the measure below.

In the Print dialog box, Page Scaling must be set to 'None'.

This line must measure two inches exactly. If it does not, please check your print setting.

TIP: Page Scaling is found at File / Print in the Page Handling section.

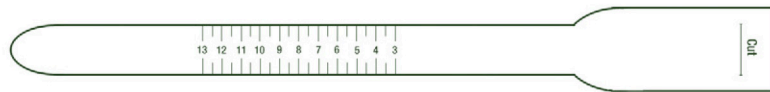


2a Measure your finger

Carefully cut out the measure below, including the slit on the wider end. Wrap it around the finger which will wear the new ring, pushing the narrow end through the slit.

Take your measurement from the widest part of the finger - this will probably be at the knuckle. Pull the measure in tightly, and read the number closest to the slit. This is your ring size.

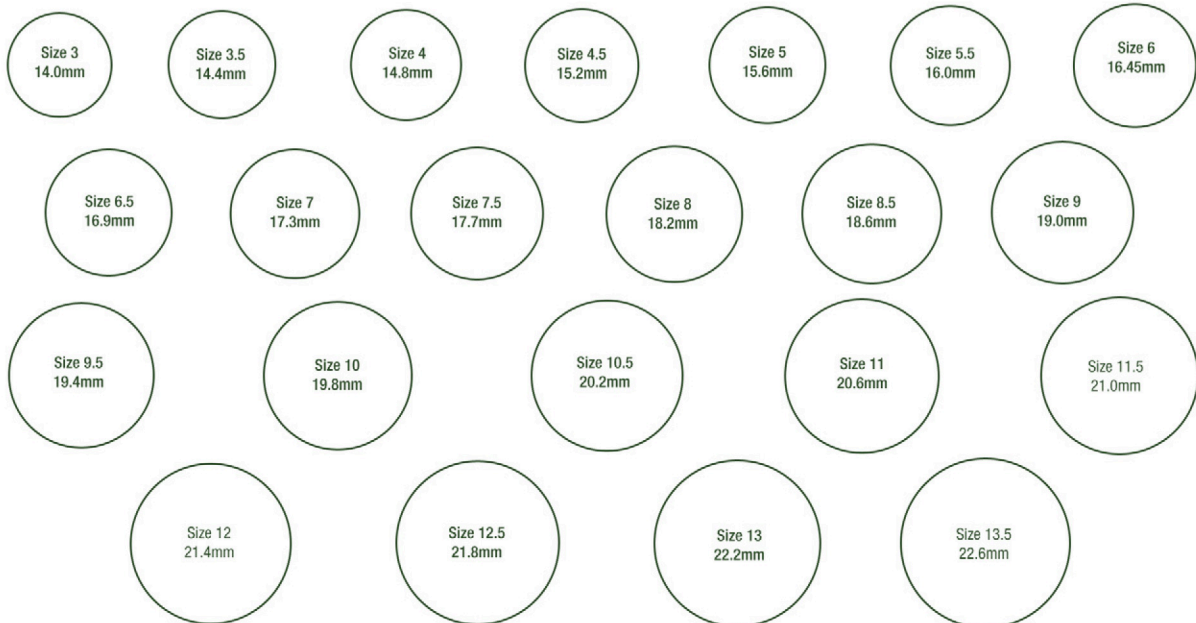
TIP: The best time to measure is later in the day, when fingers are largest. Avoid measuring cold fingers, which are at their smallest.



2b Measure an existing ring

A ring that already fits the finger which will wear the new ring can be used to find your size.

Lie the ring over the circles below. The circle which fits most closely to the inside of your ring shows the required size. If the ring falls between sizes, order your new ring in the larger size.
