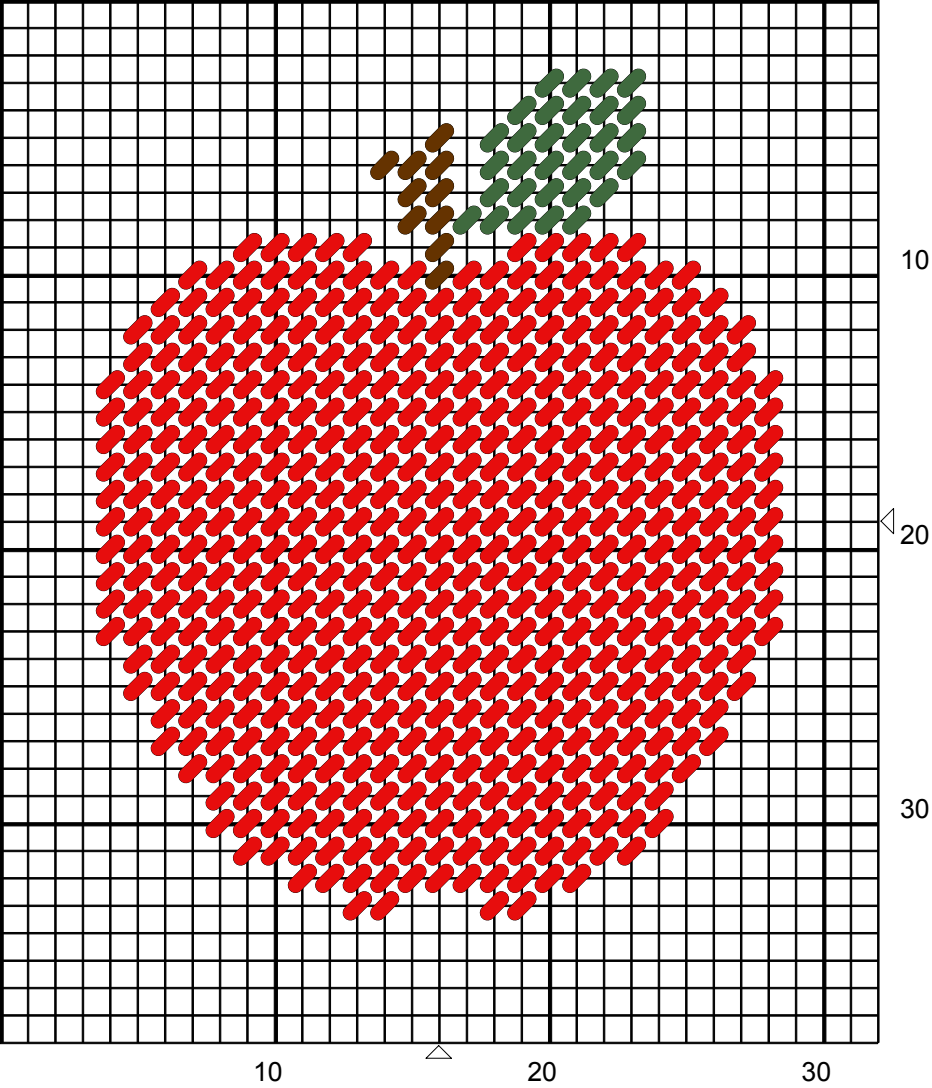


## Apple Tissue Box Cover

1. Count and cut plastic canvas according to graph.
2. Using Continental Stitch, work according to graph. Fill in all uncoded areas with light green.
3. With light green, whipstitch sides and top together to form box. Overcast unfinished edges.

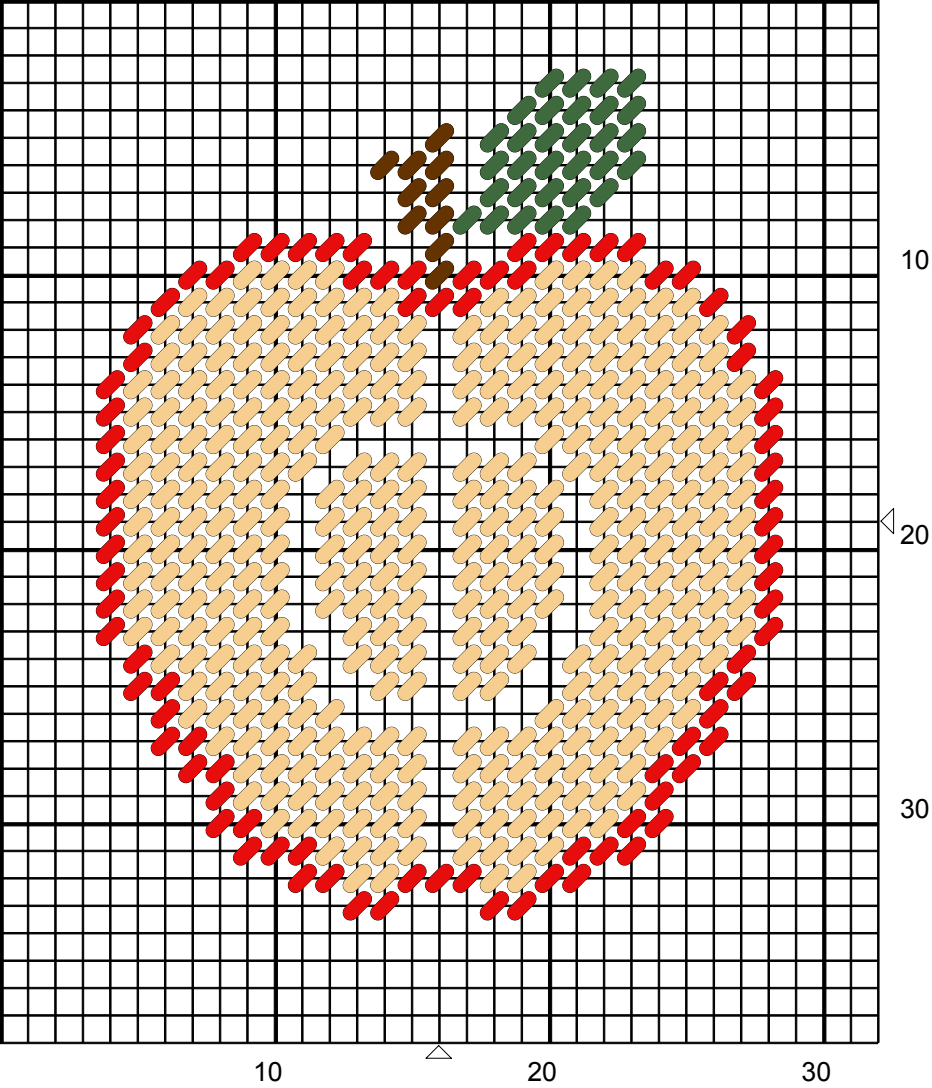

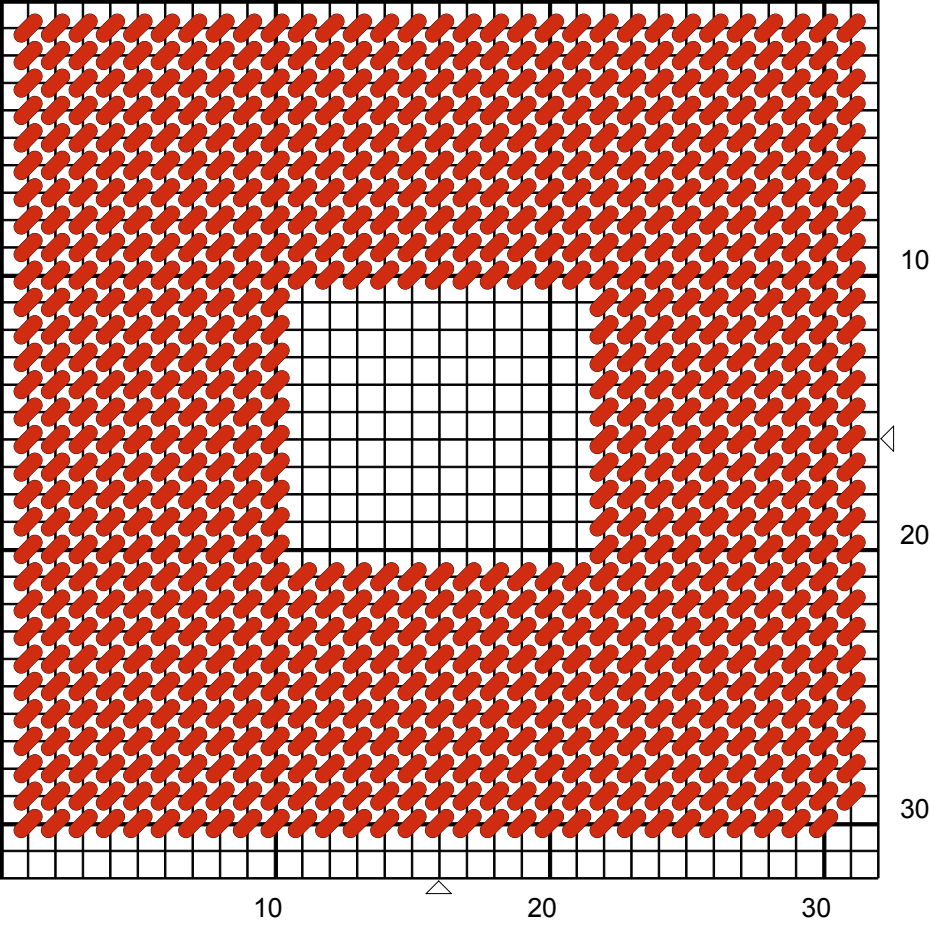

**Skip 10 squares from the left, right, top & bottom; □  
cut out center area for tissues to come through.**
